Your privacy is important to I-dance B.V. and its affiliated and subsidiary companies (hereinafter altogether "I-dance"). Therefore, I-dance is committed to respecting your privacy and the confidentiality of your personal data, traffic data and communications content. This Privacy Statement is designed to assist you in understanding how I-dance uses and safeguards the information you provide in using the I-dance service.

1. What is I-dance and what services does it offer?

I-dance B.V. is a company established under the laws of the Netherlands. I-dance is a service provider with the sole purpose of promoting Music Tracks, when, in I-dance's sole discretion, the Music Track is of potential for the establishment of a contact between any subscribers to the Service.

2. What information does I-dance collect?

I-dance collects personal information when you register with I-dance, when you use I-dance products or services, when you visit I-dance pages or the pages of certain I-dance partners, and when you enter promotions.

When you register we ask for information such as your name, email address, address. Once you register with I-dance and sign in to our services, you are not anonymous to us.

I-dance collects information about your transactions with us. I-dance automatically receives and records information on our server logs from your browser, including your IP address, I-dance cookie information, and the page you request.

3. How does I-dance use this information and for what purpose?

I-dance uses information for the following general purposes:

- fulfil your requests for products and services,
- improve our services,
- contact you, conduct research, and provide anonymous reporting for internal use.

4. To whom does I-dance transfer your personal information?

I-dance does not rent, sell, or share personal information about you with other people or non-affiliated companies except to provide products or services you've requested, when we have your permission, or under the following circumstances:

- We respond to subpoenas, court orders, or legal process, or to establish or exercise our legal rights or defend against legal claims;

- We believe it is necessary to share information in order to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the physical safety of any person, violations of I-dance terms of use, or as otherwise required by law.

- We transfer information about you if I-dance is acquired by or merged with another company. In this event, I-dance will notify you before information about you is transferred and becomes subject to a different privacy policy.

5. What are cookies and how does I-dance use them?

Cookies are pieces of information that I-dance will transfer to your computer's hard drive through your browser to enable I-dance systems to recognise your browser. Cookies also enable I-dance to gain information about the use of its Website and to enhance the Website accordingly to the preferences of the users.

The Help option on the toolbar of most browsers will tell you how to prevent your browser from accepting new cookies, how to have the browser notify you when you receive a new cookie, or how to disable cookies altogether. I-dance cookies do not contain any identifying information. Please bear in mind that some personalised services may not be available if you choose to disable cookies.

6. Can this Privacy Statement be modified?

I-dance reserves the right to modify the provisions of this Privacy Statement if deemed necessary. We will inform you of these changes on the website.
